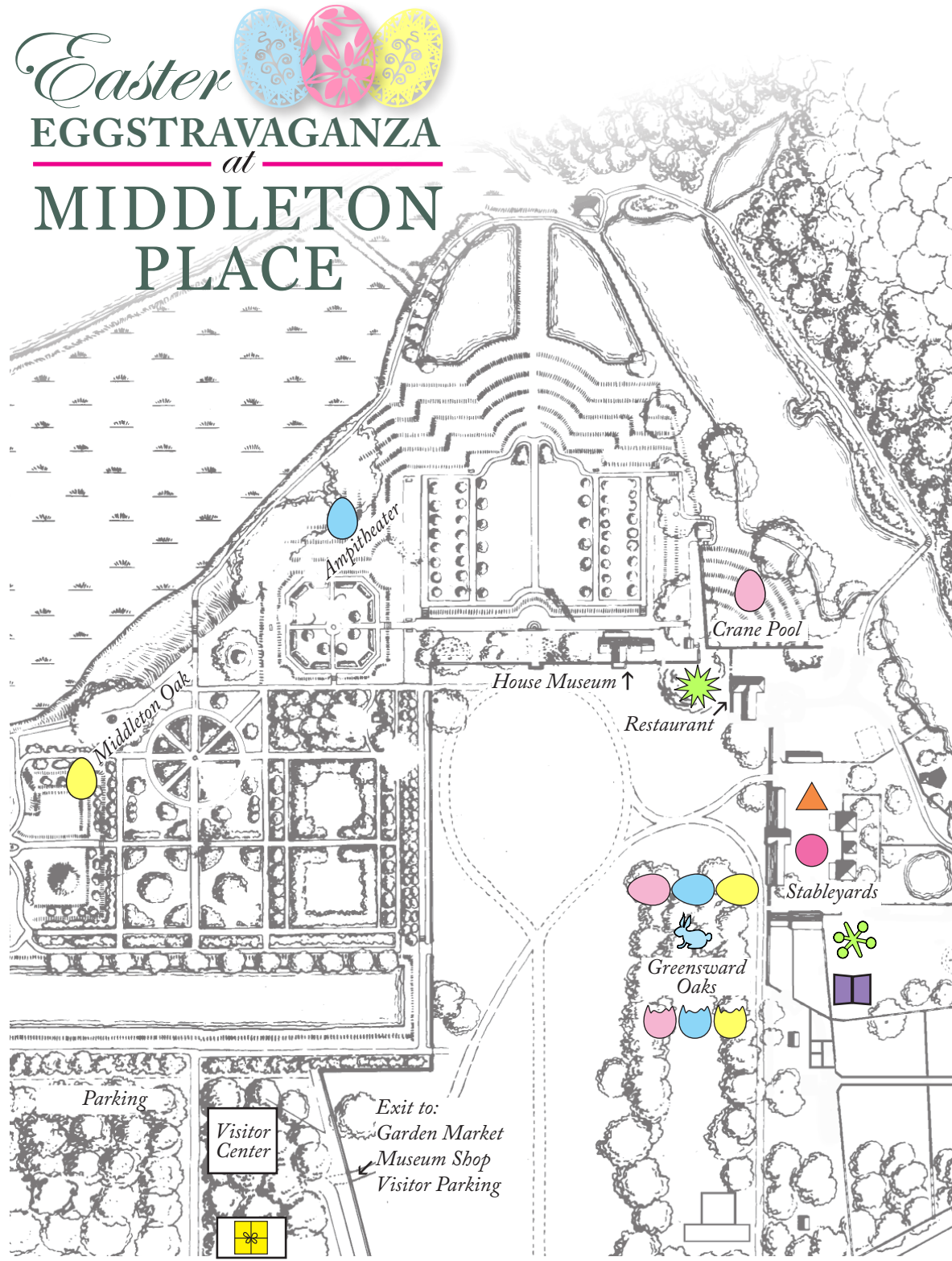

## EGG HUNTS, ROLLS AND TOSSES

Age groups are as follows:

 PINK: ages 2-4    BLUE: ages 5-7    YELLOW: ages 8-10+

## PRIZES

Ceramic prize eggs, hand-made by the Middleton Place Resident Potter, will be hidden among the undyed natural eggs. Each child may present ONE prize egg at the Prize Table to receive a prize. One Grand Prize egg (yellow and purple with "MP" written on them) will be hidden in each egg hunt. Children who find Grand Prize eggs will win an annual Family Membership. Winners of Egg Races and Rolls will also receive a certificate for a prize. The Prize Table is located in the Garden Market & Nursery (adjacent to visitor parking).

### Egg Dyeing

Dye stations available for children to decorate the hard-boiled eggs gathered during the hunt.
